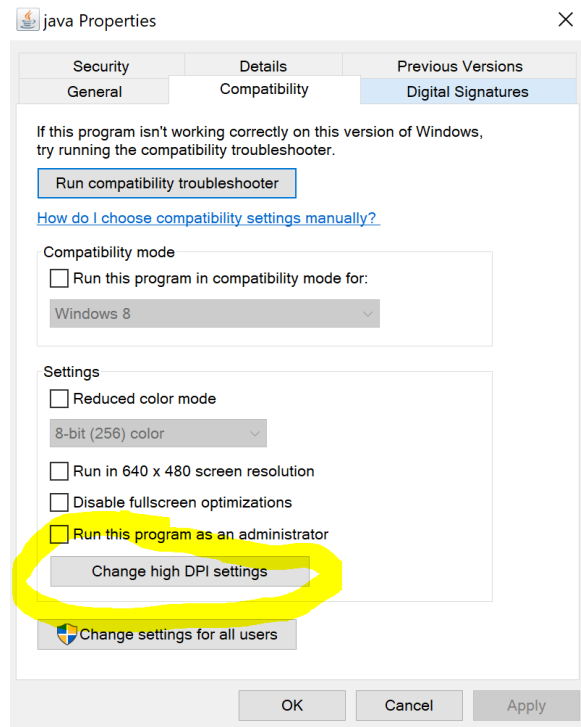
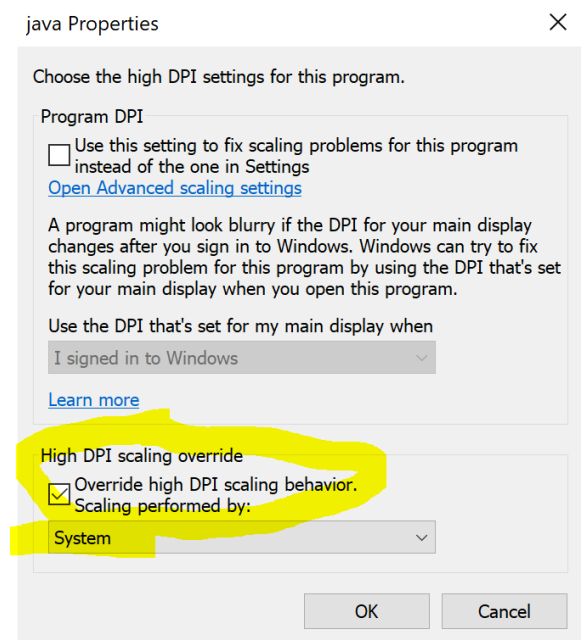


How to Fix Scaling Issues on the Java Teacher App

- 1) Navigate to C:\Program Files (x86)\Java. You will see one or more folders for the various versions of Java that are installed on your computer
- 2) Open each folder, then open the bin folder underneath it
- 3) Right-Click “javaw.exe” and click Properties
- 4) Click the Compatibility Tab
- 5) Click on “Change high DPI Settings”



- 6) Check the box next to “Override high DPI scaling behavior.”
 - a. In the dropdown, select System instead of Application
- 7) Close the properties window, then repeat for the following executable files:
 - a. “javaws.exe”
 - b. “java.exe”
 - c. “javacpl.exe”



- 8) Repeat the above steps for each of the folders under C:\Program Files (x86)\Java
- 9) Repeat the above steps for each of the folders under C:\Program Files\Java (IF the folder exists)
- 10) Note that this will likely have to be performed again whenever Java is updated, since it will create a new folder for every version.
